LLCS school sweatshirt hoodies will be acceptable on school spirit days only. Clothing must fit appropriately If students come to school wearing inappropriate clothing they will be given a school shirt to wear for the day.

LLCS Dress and Grooming Code: non-uniform days:

Dress and grooming at Learning for Leadership charter School in the following manner is prohibited:

- Wearing clothing that includes words or pictures which are obscene, vulgar, discriminatory, or which promote or advertise alcohol, chemicals, tobacco, or any other product that is illegal for use by minors.
- Creates a hazard to the safety of him/herself or others;
- And/or creates a health hazard.
- Wearing clothing or grooming in a manner that represents and/or promotes threat/hate groups including gangs or supremacist groups.
- Dress and grooming of students that causes actual distraction from or disturbance in any school activity or actually interferes with the participation of a student in any school activity.
- Wearing clothing or grooming in a manner that is sexually explicit or which conveys sexual innuendo or that may reasonably be construed as sexual. Tank tops, shorts, and showing of underwear and breast cleavage are included.
- Shorts and skirts must be longer than the fingertips when the arm is down along the body in school. There are no exceptions.
- Wearing oversized garments, jackets for outdoor wear in school, sagging pants,
- Wearing masks or grooming that limits or prevents the identification of a student.
- Wearing hats, bandanas, and dew rags.

The Director reserves the right to deny admission to school functions based on dress and/or grooming determined to be inappropriate and/or disruptive to the educational process. Students may be sent home or given clothing to wear over the offending clothes.
